- Cases of bottled water
- Hard-sided trunks
- Alcohol, tobacco, or drugs
- Weapons of any kind, including toy guns (Orbeez, Nerf, etc.)

Storage Provided at Camp

Please do not bring plastic drawers or trunks as they take up a large amount of floor space and present a tripping hazard.
