## Storage Provided at Camp

In the bunk, campers and staff alike are provided with storage during their session. Storage (cubbies) is pre-assigned to be fair and provide everyone with the same, appropriate amount of storage space. Please do not bring plastic drawers or trunks as they take up a large amount of floor space and present a tripping hazard.
