Prohibited Items

- Cell phones, computers, tablets, or any device with internet capabilities or touch screens
- E-readers, iPads, game devices- anything with a screen that may play videos or games
- Shoes with high-heels or with wheels
- Alcohol, tobacco, or drugs
- Weapons of any kind, including toy guns (Orbeez, Nerf, etc.)
- Plastic drawers (unless in cubbies) or hard-sided trunks
- Cases of bottled water

Theme Outfits

At GFC, we have a lot of *ruach* (spirit) and have special programs that our community likes to dress up for. You may pack clothing or accessories for the following themes:

- · Shabbat: White top with khaki or colored bottoms/jean shorts, white dress, full white outfit
- Maccabiah (Color Wars): Clothing in our four team colors: red, yellow, green, blue (Niviim-S'gamin)
- Spectacular Day: Patriotic or 4th of July themed (last weekend of both sessions)
- Erev Yisrael (Israel Evening): Blue and white
- Fun outfits or accessories for other dress up days! Think Disney, neon, Hawaiian shirts, etc.

Storage Provided at Camp

In the bunk, capers and staff alike are provided with storage (cubbies). Cubbies are pre-assigned to be fair and provide everyone the appropriate amount of storage space.

- Cubby dimensions inside cabin: 10.5" wide x 10" tall (campers will have 4-6 cubbies near their bed).
- Cubby dimensions inside foyer: 17.5" wide x 10" tall (campers will have up to 3 cubbies in the foyer).
- Small cubbies in the bathroom and over the cabin sink also provided.
- S'ganim and Kibbutz cubbies are of varying sizes within the cabin, no foyer.

Labeling

All clothing and belongings must be clearly labeled with camper's full name. We suggest using laundry-marking pens or sew-on, iron-on, or stick-on labels. Feel free to take advantage of our 25% discount code at <u>Label Daddy</u>, <u>www.labeldaddy.com</u>, by using promo code GREENE at checkout.
